



ADDITIONAL STEP BY STEP INSTRUCTIONS BY HAIR TYPE

2. PROTECTION

VIRGIN HAIR

We don't recommend using any protective products.

SINGLE-PROCESSED HAIR

- Apply Agave Fixx + Agave Protect.
- Apply all over hair from roots through ends using the applicator brush.

MULTI-CHEMICAL HAIR

- Apply Agave Fix + Agave Protect on all highlighted and porous areas.

3. PROCEED TO CREAM APPLICATION #1

VIRGIN HAIR

- Part in 4 quadrants
- Apply from crown to nape, 1/3 inch from scalp to mid-shaft
- Proceed to the front area and apply from top parting, down to ears.
- Average process time is 25 minutes. (45 minutes maximum, for extremely resistant hair)
- When the hair is 60-70% straight, run ReTex through the ends from the nape down. Make sure to use Agave Protect if needed.

SINGLE-PROCESSED HAIR

- Part hair in four quadrants.
- Apply from crown to nape, 1/4 inch from scalp to mid-shaft.
- After finished applying to back sections, proceed to the front area and apply from top parting down to ears.
- Perform elasticity test every 5 minutes. When hair is 60-70% percent straight, run ReTex through the ends from the nape down. Make sure to use Agave Protect if needed.

MULTI-CHEMICAL HAIR

- Part hair in four quadrants.
- At the occipital bone area, section hair from ear to ear and pin up.
- Start application from the occipital bone area, parting down to the nape first. Continue at crown, down to the occipital bone part.

6. FLAT IRON

VIRGIN HAIR

- 5 passes with flat iron at 400° as follows:
 - 2 passes from roots to mid-shaft
 - 3 passes from roots all the way through the ends

SINGLE-PROCESSED HAIR

- 4 passes with flat iron at 300° as follows:
 - 2 passes from roots to mid-shaft
 - 2 passes from roots all the way through the ends

MULTI-CHEMICAL HAIR

- 2 passes with flat iron at 300° as follows:
 - 1 pass from roots to mid-shaft
 - 1 pass from roots all the way through the ends

STEP BY STEP

6. FLAT IRON

- Flat iron hair. (Refer to Page 4 for exact temperatures and passes according to hair type)
- Make sure to run the comb in front of the iron. Iron slowly, starting at nape. Total iron time: 30 minutes



7. BEGIN CREAM #2 APPLICATION

- Part hair in quadrants. Apply Cream #2 from scalp to ends or from scalp to line of demarcation.
- Always start application at the back of head, from crown to nape.
- Apply Cream #2 to each quadrant, applying section by section, folding them over. No need for plastic clips.
- Application should be very liberal. Make sure application takes no more than 10 minutes.
- Allow Cream #2 to process for 5-7 minutes, depending on hair type. Fine or processed hair: 5 minutes . Thick or resistant hair: 7 minutes



8. RINSE

- Rinse with WARM water for ten minutes until water runs clear. DO NOT use cold water.
- DO NOT shampoo. Make sure there is no product left on the hair.
- If needed, apply Agave Restorative Hydrating Mask all over hair from mid-shaft through to ends. Let product sit for 5 minutes then rinse.
- Towel dry, patting carefully.



9. PROCEED TO DRY AND STYLE

- Blow dry as desired. Style as desired.
- Time Before Next Color Treatment:
VIRGIN/SINGLE-PROCESSED HAIR - Wait 7 days

MULTI-CHEMICAL OR HIGHLIGHT PROCESSED HAIR - Wait 10 days



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STEP BY STEP

Important: Reference Page 4 for specific instructions for different hair types (Virgin, Single-Processed, Multi-Chemical Processed).

1. CLARIFY HAIR

- Use Agave Clarifying Shampoo to remove any product build-up.
- Shampoo twice. Do not apply conditioner. Towel dry.



2. PROTECTION

- Apply Agave Fixx and Agave Protect to hair.
- (Refer to Page 4 for specific instructions for different hair types)



3. PROCEED TO CREAM #1 APPLICATION

- Comb the hair thoroughly and section is at the same time, evenly distributing protective products. (Refer to Page 4 for details)
- Part hair into quadrants for all applications. Apply Cream #1 to section. Fold the section over. Thick cream will help keep the section in place; no need for plastic clips. Total application time: 10 minutes



4. RINSE

- Rinse with warm water for 10 minutes until water runs clear.
- DO NOT shampoo. Make sure there is no product on nape area.
- Towel dry hair, patting carefully. DO NOT twist the hair. Detangle with Agave Brush or wide tooth comb.



5. BLOW DRY

- Dry hair with a professional blow dryer. Begin drying the hair using downward movements with fingers. Once hair is 50% dry, use Agave Paddle Brush to finish blow dry.
- Use sections and start from the nape of the head and work your way up.

WARNINGS

DO NOT apply on hair that has been treated with henna or sodium hydroxide, lithium hydroxide, guanidine carbonate, and calcium hydroxide/calcium oxide blend or no-lye (lithium hydroxide) straightened hair.

DO NOT allow contact with eyes. If contact with eyes does occur, flush immediately with water for 15 minutes. Get immediate medical attention.

DO NOT ingest or cause to be ingested. If ingested, immediately contact Poison Control Center.

DO NOT apply on severely damaged or over processed hair with no elasticity.
